Recommended experiences near the spa resort

The Ptuj Sea – Ptuj lake and Wakepark 4 km

The Ptuj lake on the Drava River is one of the largest artificial lakes in Slovenia, with a walking trail that leads around the lake. From Terme Ptuj, you can reach the Ranca sports and recreation centre by foot or by bike. In the summer, the lake offers a wealth of water sports and activities. Here you can also wake in the first "Vejkpark" in Slovenia. www.wakepark.si



Wakepark Dooplek 23 km

Up to 7 visitors can skate or ski on the water in the Wakepark in the Drava Natural Park, reaching up to 40 km/h. www.dooplek.si



Vurberk Adventure Park by the Vurberk Castle 13 km

The Vurberk Adventure Park is located right beside the castle. Climbing enthusiasts and adrenaline junkies can try their hand at three treetop courses of varying difficulty levels. Visit the remains of the mysterious Vurberk Castle and absorb the healing energy at the many energy points. www.pustolovski-vurberk.si



Betnava Adventure Park 28 km

The forest by the Bentava mansion hosts an adventure park with seven trails of different difficulties that lead up the trees, posts, various bridges and ropes 1–8 m above the floor. www.pustolovski-park.si



Little Red Riding Hood's fairytale forest 13 km

Enjoy a family adventure in Little Red Riding Hood's fairytale forest (Mohorkova graba). In the fairytale houses set in natural green surroundings, you will find scenes from famous fairytales. The fairytale houses are open from Friday to Sunday.



Mariborsko Pohorje 31 km

Mariborsko Pohorje is the largest ski centre in Slovenia. Visitors can take a ski lift to the summit to enjoy the magnificent views. In the summer, Pohorje offers a bike park, an adrenaline-filled summer sledding track PohorJET and countless hiking trails. www.visitpohorje.si



Golf on the Ptuj Golf Course 200 m

Right beside Terme Ptuj, you can find a wonderful golf course with 18 holes. A special feature of the Ptuj Golf Course, which has the most water obstacles among Slovenian courses, is the 14th hole on an island. www.golf-ptuj.si

Natural and cultural attractions

Ptuj Castle ● 2 km

Walk up the hill to the Ptuj Castle to enjoy wonderful views. Today's castle is the result of centuries of renovations and rebuilding. After WWII, it became a museum.

Ptujska Gora and the basilica Our Lady of Mercy ● 13 km

Ptujska Gora is a village nucleated around a square and an imposing Gothic church, which stands atop a hill and is visible from a considerable distance. The beautiful views of Dravsko polje and Haloze make the hill a popular destination for hikers and cyclists.

The Third Mitra Shrine in Zgornji Breg ● 2 km

In the Western part of the Roman Petoviona, in today's Zgornji Breg, the largest shrine to the god Mitra was built in the densely populated residential quarters of the town. The shrine, that was built in the mid 3rd century, is protected as a heritage building.



Holy Trinity Church in Slovenske gorice ● 25 km

The Baroque Holy Trinity Church is the most interesting sight in the town. Local legend says that three lights used to show in that place. This was understood as a sign to build a church dedicated to the Holy Trinity.

Štrumovci Nature Park ● 12 km

During your visit to Lake Ptuj, don't miss the Štrumovci Nature Park, where a completely different world awaits: gravel deposits, shoals, floodplain forests and beautiful meadows sparsely dotted with trees and resembling a manicured castle park.



Dominko's homestead ● 14 km

Dominkova House is one of the oldest completely preserved houses built in the Pannonian style. It is more than 300 years old and reflects the way of life in those times.

The Puh Museum ● 21 km

The perfect choice for classic car enthusiasts, this museum houses exhibits created by the inventor Janez Puh. During World War I, he built the famous Puch motorcycle and one of the most reliable cars.

Bistrica Gorge ● 30 km

The picturesque gorge created by the Bistrica Brook in full of natural wonders. The trail leads past a Roman quarry, the Bistriški Šum waterfall, several mill ruins and the thickest fir in this part of Europe.

Baroque Štatenberg mansion ● 21 km

Štatenber is a luxurious baroque mansion situated on a panoramic hill above the Makole village. It was first built by the Attems counts, in possibly as early as 1696. The mansion is surrounded by a beautiful park.

TAL 2000 Botanical Garden ● 17 km

In this botanical garden you can see the largest collection of aquatic and riparian plants in Slovenia, a collection of poisonous and healing plants and a small collection of minerals and stones. Children can venture into the fairytale land of Parzival the Knight.

Ptuj – the treasury of the millennia ● 2 km

Ptuj, Slovenia's oldest town, boasts a rich and colourful past. Walk through the old city centre and visit the Dominican and the Minorite monastery or sit down in one of the cafés in the main square.

Ptuj Wine Cellar ● 2 km

Distinguished by over 700 years of tradition, the Ptuj wine cellar is the oldest in Slovenia. It has the most extensive wine treasury with an admirable collection of archive wines – the oldest one being Zlata trta from 1917.

Kobal Wines ● 2 km

The Kobal Wines is one of the younger wineries, which found its home in the oldest house in Ptuj. The first series of wines under the Kobal Wines label were put on the market in 2016. The winery gladly hosts demanding wine experts as well as people who just want to enjoy a glass of good wine.

Your moment in nature. You can visit the villa decorated with 19th century furniture and see a special pig species – mangalica. You can also enjoy local specialties and the wonderful view from the hill where the villa is located.

Vid's Cellar is a promotional centre for wine growers from the Haloze wine territory, offering more than 25 different bottled quality and premium wines by 15 wine-makers from Haloze. They offer guided wine tastings and organise different events.

Drive along the Wine Route and experience the Jeruzalem hills: land of quality wines, welcoming locals and charming nature. The Bernholc Wine Estate is located in the more than 300 year-old Furst mansion. Enjoy the specialties of Prlekija and the premium wines from vineyards of Ljutomersko-ormoške gorice at the highest point of these beautiful vine-growing hills.

Šuman Ecologic and Biodynamic Winery ● 22 km

Wine-making has been a tradition in the Šuman family for several generations. They work on almost 14 hectares of vineyards in accordance with the ecological farming principles. They also offer professional guided wine tastings. www.vino-suman.eu



Širec Agritourism Farm ● 13 km

The Širec farm is located on the hill Krčevine pri Vurberku with a wonderful view of the surroundings. They offer local specialties and guided wine tastings led by Svetlana Širec, the Slovenian Wine Queen of 2008.

Selinšek Farm and Lavender from Štajerska ● 10 km

You can enjoy the view of purple fields of lavender in Štajerska at the Selinšek farm, where 15,000 lavender plants were planted in 2010. They organise a traditional lavender festival in summer with guided tours and lavender workshops and products.

Pislak Beekeeping ● 7 km

At Pislak Beekeeping, the largest beekeeping farm in Slovenia, the beekeeping tradition has been kept alive for three generations, since 1964. Their shop sells home-made honey products: royal jelly, honey and honey-based liqueur.
